



# MTT PEG 'N POLE



## OVERVIEW

The traditional marquee still used today in large numbers but are dwindling through competition with the newer more advanced type of structures that are more stable and aesthetically pleasing to the eye. The tents consist normally of single rows of main poles and side poles attached to the perimeter of the tent then pulled out on ropes and anchored to pegs in the ground. The roofs have no tensile patterning and flap in inclement weather.

## SELLING POINTS:

They are used mainly in areas where the people still go for traditional look or in the market for a cheaper tent.

- 5m x 5m extending in 5m extensions
- 6m x 6m extending in 6m extensions
- 6m x 9m extending in 6m extensions
- 9m x 9m extending in 6m/ 9m extensions
- 9m x 12m extending in 6m/9m extensions
- 12m x12m extending in 6m/9m extensions
- 13,5m x 13.5 extending in 6m/9m extensions
- 15m x15m extending in 6m /9m extensions
